She has led listening forums on racism in healthcare, introduced policies on care for the LGBTQ community, and worked with community leaders on equitable access and education on the COVID-19 vaccine. All this plus her work on the AONL Diversity and Belonging Committee will support DAISY's focus on the role of nurses advancing health equity through recognition and research. Deb is a Fellow in the American Academy of Nursing.
